Over the course of 25 years, our organization has evolved from a handful of Japanese citizens scrambling to raise operating funds for a lone orphanage in Thailand, to a flourishing, government certified NPO active in improving the lives of the socially vulnerable in three Asian nations across the world. In order to nurture the future leaders of tomorrow, TPAK has historically partnered with countless educational institutions to provide leadership opportunities to bright, young students across Japan. Starting this year, TPAK has decided to establish two internship programs which will be conducted entirely in English, in order to strengthen and diversify its organizational environment.
